

FIRST WORLD SERVICE CONFERENCE
Ventura California
November 13, 1976

The First World Service Conference resulted from several years of phone calls and letters among members of the Fellowship interested in developing greater unity, better communication and expression of the group conscience of N.A.

The Conference included participants from 14 States and 2 Foreign Countries. There were 37 participants in all. The Conference lasted 1 ½ days. The notes and minutes (of sorts) that were taken of this first Conference are imprecise and lack great detail.

The general result of this first Conference was to formulate Committees to work more diligently on new N.A. literature and a Book on Recovery and also to develop more clearly the guidelines, policies and Structure of N.A.

No specific record was kept of the motions made at this Conference.
